Undergraduate Disciplinary Hearing to Determine Additional Sanctions

Heard by: University Academic Integrity Hearing Board

Process to determine additional sanctions for a student accused of academic misconduct and for whom sanctions in addition to, or other than a penalty grade are requested. 1, 2

Instructor alleges student has cheated, issues a penalty grade and requests student's dean to call for a disciplinary hearing to consider additional sanctions. ³ (See Integrity of Scholarship and Grades policy).

> Student's Dean notifies the Dean of Students Office of request for disciplinary hearing to consider additional sanctions.

The Dean of Students Office notifies student of meeting to discuss disposition of case. 4

Student opts for disciplinary

- 4. If the student fails to meet with the Associate Provost for Undergraduate Education, the Dean of Students Office will refer the case to the UAIHB.
